**Fly Fishing Workshop
May 31-June 3, 2012
Lakeside Lodge
Sinclair, Maine**

This workshop will introduce you to the sport of fly fishing. Participants will begin with an overview of equipment, then basic fly casting instruction followed by fly tying and an evening fly fishing on the Cross Lake Thoroughfare. The second day will include a canoe trip on the Square Lake Thoroughfare to fish for wild brook trout and landlocked salmon with instructors. Wading skills, canoe handling, proper catch and release techniques will be covered.

**Moose Calling for Photography
September 13-16, 2012**

This in-depth workshop will provide participants with the opportunity to learn about calling-in moose in the Maine wilderness. Participants will learn how to use a basic moose call as well as voice calling techniques, about basic moose language, use of scent, introductory decoy skills, moose behavior and senses, identifying sign and will have the opportunity to call in a moose on their own. This course can be used by hunters, guides, photographers and for those who wish to become more adept at wildlife watching.

**Trapping Program
October 31-November 4**

Participants will learn the basics of water trapping for muskrat, mink, raccoon, otter, beaver and the basics of land trapping for marten, fisher, weasel, raccoon, fox and coyote. Each participant will skin at least one animal and see other animals skinned. Participants will learn how to set different types of traps for all Maine furbearers. Participants will also learn alternative markets for fur and other animal parts as well personal uses for furs. Trap line safety and basic woodsmanship will also be taught. An apprentice trapping license is recommended.
